ELIGIBLE SUBJECTS	Young researchers defined as follows: researcher of any nationality who has not yet gained consolidated experience in the management of research groups and is not in a contractual position such as to guarantee him a stable career prospect in the field of research. Young researchers up to the age of 40 years, or aged between 40 and 45 years provided that they have completed their PhD for a maximum of 7 years who are in one or more of the following conditions: - having to acquire first experience as a fund manager and/or research activity - P.I.; - need to acquire experience in the leadership and management of a national and/or international research team; - does not have, or not have had before winning the European grant, a permanent Full Time Equivalent (FTE) contract as a tenured researcher and/or professor. Must meet one of the following minimum requirements: - winner of an MSCA-IF call (Horizon 2020) who has completed their project no more than 60 months from the date of publication of this Notice (04.07.2024). The project must be complementary or consequential to the funded MSCA activities; - winner of an MSCA-PF call (Horizon Europe) who has completed their project no more than 60 months from the date of publication of this Notice (04.07.2024). The project must be complementary or consequential to the funded MSCA activities; - have received, in the 24 months prior to the date of publication of this Notice, the communication relating to the attribution of the SoE for participation in an MSCA-PF (Horizon Europe) call. The project must be the same as the one that received the SoE, remodelled for the part of the economic-financial plan and the timetable and must be preevaluated by the Host Institution.
